Monica Mondardini (Cesena, 1960) has been Chief Executive Officer of CIR since May 2013.

She is also Chairwoman of Sogefi and Board Member of KOS.

She graduated in Statistical and Economic Science from the University of Bologna.

She began her career in 1985 at Gruppo Editoriale Fabbri and in 1990 she joined Hachette Livre, first managing the Spanish branch and then, in 1993, was appointed Director of the international branch as a member of the Executive Committee of Hachette Livre, based in Paris.

In 1998 she joined the Generali Group until 2008, first as Managing Director of Europ Assistance, then as Group Management Control Director, based in Trieste. Finally, since 2001, she was appointed CEO of Generali Spain, based in Madrid.

Shee has served as an independent director in leading listed companies, including SCOR, Crédit Agricole, Edenred, and currently Hera S.p.A..

In 2006, she received the “Targa all’Italianità” from the Comites Madrid, an award reserved for Italians residing in Spain who have brought prestige to their home country.

In 2014, she was honored by the Embassy of France in Rome and the French Chamber of Commerce and Industry in Italy as Economic Personality of the Year for her contribution to relations between the two countries.

In 2016, she was awarded the title of “Chevalier dans l’ordre de la Légion d’Honneur”.
